12. **To sell at the market during special events, i.e. craft fairs, you must have attended a minimum of three previous market days to qualify.**
13. Note that vendors may sell only products they themselves produce. Please read the Farmers' Market Rules for details about product eligibility requirements.

Produce, Minor Crops: Dry beans, Belgian endive, burdock, cardoon, celery, celeriac, chicory, collards, endive, escarole, fava beans, garlic, greens for salad mixes (baby lettuce, baby spinach, arugula, cress, Asian greens, mustard greens, salad burnet, etc.), gourds, culinary herbs, medicinal herbs, horseradish, kale, cultivated mushrooms, wild mushrooms, okra, green onions, parsnips, shelling peas, snap peas, snow peas, hot peppers, radicchio, radishes, rutabagas, salsify, shallots, shoots and sprouts, spinach, sweet potatoes, Swiss chard, tomatillos, turnips.
